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4.5 Assessment

For Perspectives in Education and Curriculum and Pedagogic Studies, at least 20% to 30% marks may be assigned for continuous internal assessment and 70% to 80% marks for external examination. One-fourth of the total marks weightage shall be allocated to assessment of practice teaching. The weightage for internal and external assessment shall be prescribed by the affiliating university Candidates must be internally assessed on the course of Engagement with the Field and not only on the project field work given to them as part of per units of study. The basis for assessment and criteria used ought to be transparent for students to herefit consumally out of professional feedback. Students shall be given information about their grades marks as part of professional feedback so that they get the opportunity to improve their performance. The bases of internal assessment may include individual or group assignments, observation records, student portfolio, diaries, journal
